At the recent Texas Floral Forum, held in San Antonio, I had the honor of presenting the 2024 TSFA Achievement Award. The recipient, Norman Northen TMFA, has been a devoted TSFA member with a floral industry journey that is a true testament to passion and perseverance, accompanied with the support of a loving family.

After graduating from college, Norman pursued his love of floral design, establishing a business in Belton, Texas, with the encouragement and support of his grandmother. She purchased and renovated a historical house, transforming it into a stunning venue for intimate events, such as bridal and baby showers, luncheons and receptions. Norman's talents extended far beyond floral design, as he also excelled in catering, often enlisting the help of family to bring these events to life.

Norman's career flourished as he worked at various florists in the area and owned his shop, the Bluebonnet Patch, for eight years. He eventually became the design team lead at Precious Memories Florist and Gifts in Temple, Texas, from 1995 until

his recent retirement. Norman's creativity and leadership has left an incredible mark on the industry.

An award-winning designer, Norman's journey to distinction began in the 1990s when he competed in TSFA's Texas Cup, now known as the Texas Designer of the Year Competition. Reflecting on his experiences, Norman shared in the April issue of TEXAS in Bloom magazine:

"Winning the Texas Designer of the Year Competition was the most rewarding part of my floral journey. Back in the day, 30-40 designers competed at a preliminary competition. The top tier was selected to compete in the finals at TSFA Convention. You very seldom won your first time out. Lifelong friends were made. TSFA President Susan Piland and I became friends and later TSFA Presidents. I competed for seven years, was in the finals five times and finally won in 2001. I have designed throughout our great state and thank TSFA for the opportunities. Every designer should compete at least once."

Even in retirement, Norman's passion for floristry remains undiminished. Instead of a quaint farewell retirement party,

Norman also takes pride in getting "ME" back and involved in TSFA. He offered to stay on as Past President Liaison during my presidency. Saying, "Well Susan, I kind of got you back into this, so I better help you out." Norman, I'm so thankful!

Through all these endeavors, Norman always ties in his love for Texas State Florists' Association.

Lynn's journey into the world of floristry began at a young age when her mother opened a flower shop during Lynn's fourth grade year. This early exposure to the beauty and artistry of flowers sparked a lifelong passion. Lynn and Mark met at Texas A&M University. Following his graduation, they married and moved to California where he served as an officer in the Marine Corps. They will celebrate 50 years of marriage later this year!

Her designs have been featured in numerous floral magazines and wire service design books. Lynn has also promoted the floral industry on television and radio, sharing her passion and knowledge with a broader audience. As the editor of *TEXAS* in *Bloom*, her love for this industry is poured out on every page.

Lynn has also been a significant contributor to many TSFA Hall of Fame awards, including the Allied Florists of Houston, TSFA Past Presidents, TSFA Education Committee and the Texas Floral Endowment. As a founding member of the Texas Floral Endowment over 33 years ago and the CEO of the AIFD Foundation since 2017, Lynn's impact on the floral industry through these charitable organizations is profound. Her generosity and dedication have touched and changed so many lives. It is only fitting she is awarded her own place in the TSFA Hall of Fame.

Her daughters, Georgeanne and Shauna, share their heartfelt memories: "We have so many memories from a childhood surrounded by flowers and serving our community through Lary's Florist. While we may have been in violation of child labor laws as we helped scrub buckets, process flowers, set up weddings, run deliveries, answer phones, make trimmings for homecoming mums, and sweep the design floor, a childhood spent watching our mother make a difference in the lives of so many people was a well-spent childhood. Whether it was making a bride's dream come true or providing comfort to a grieving family, Mom was always focused on making the most meaningful moments in people's lives as close to perfection as she possibly could. From watching her lead at the local, state and national level in her industry, we learned the value of leadership, collaboration and giving of self. From watching her lead at the flower shop, we learned lessons of hard work, customer service, the value of relationships and the importance of giving to the community. She has always been the Lifetime Achievement Award • Hall of Fame • VIP award winner for our family, and we are so proud of all she has accomplished."




